Commute Trip Reduction incentive reminders

Have you signed up for RideShareOnline?

Want to reduce stress, save money and help the environment when you share a ride to work? [Commuter Trip Reduction](#) (CTR) is a statewide program promoting alternative commute options. When you join, you'll earn an incentive while saving on commute costs!

To qualify, you must use an alternative commute option for at least 50% of your commute distance. There is no required number of trips in a quarter, so you can get paid for a single day — or for every workday you use an alternative commuting option.

Important information for Olympia CTR users

Beginning in July of this year, Olympia has moved away from the former Excel reporting method. We're now using [RideshareOnline](#).

RideshareOnline.com is a convenient and easy-to-use tool for the traveling public to help reduce traffic congestion, improve air quality, and sustain the quality of life in our region. The service is managed by the Washington State Department of Transportation, and Services are available in Spanish and English.

This service will be the only available reporting tool to record CTR hours beginning Jan. 1, 2026.
